High School Fellowship Opportunity with the Office of State Senator Becca Rausch

Description: Recently re-elected to her third term, Massachusetts State Senator Becca Rausch (D-Needham) is a proven champion of intersectional equity, strengthening our democracy, and stellar service to her constituents. **The Senator’s High School Fellow Program is a two-week summer program for students who are residents of the Norfolk, Worcester, and Middlesex District and have completed at least one year of high school; 2025 high school graduates are also eligible to apply.** The program is designed to give high school students a chance to experience work in government and politics firsthand. Students will come to the State House Monday through Thursday for two weeks between June and August.

High School Fellows will:

- Attend briefings and committee hearings and write reports accordingly
- Observe high-level policy meetings and discussions with senior staff
- Engage in policy research as appropriate
- Have access to the summer internship seminar program at the State House
- Draft responses to constituent concerns and conduct administrative work, as needed
